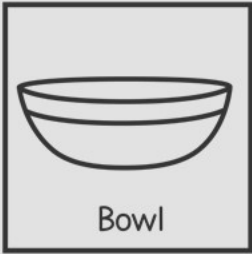

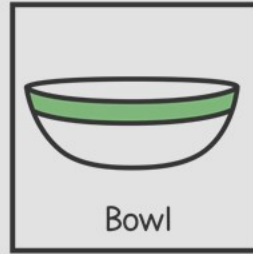

Writing Craft –
The students need two pages printed in order to complete the writing craft (the popcorn page and the writing page).

The writing page comes in a dotted lines version and plain lines version, simply choose which style suits your students.

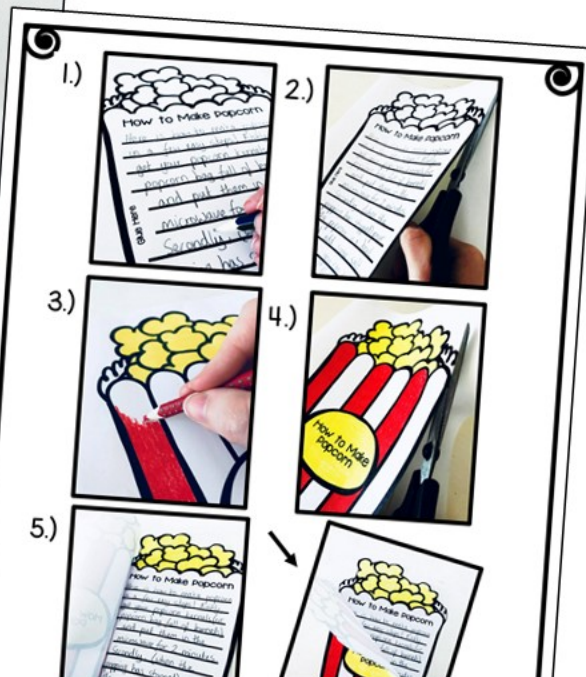
